



Themuri Sulamanidze is an Estonian/ Georgian rooted musician, arranger and a music teacher. He started his studies 1994 in popjazz piano in G.Ots Music School in Tallinn, then continued his studies in Helsinki Metropolia Popjazz Music department as a popjazz music theory teacher (BA). 2013 he attained a master's degree in music pedagogy in Tartu University Viljandi Culture Academy.

As a musician he has performed alone and with many different estonian musicians/ bands, playing mainly pop/ rock/ jazz. As an arranger he has arranged more than 200 children songs from different Estonian composers working in the field. As a teacher he has taught piano, music theory, ensemble, arranging, improvisation and other subjects to 3 - 60 years old. Currently he is holding a place as a lecturer in Tartu University Viljandi Culture Academy, teaching there all the before mentioned subjects. Some of his other interests are estonian national handicraft, especially woodworking/ wood turning and making percussion instruments.
